Minutes of Meeting  
August 08, 2016

Present: Bob Bell, William "Chip" Ball, Doug O'Clair, Chief Edward Andersen, Chad Stamps, Cindy Rouillard.

The meeting came to order at 7:35 p.m.

- Check Reports were reviewed and signed
- The Board approve the July 23rd minutes with corrections.
- Chad Stamps stated he would like to offer his assistance to update the town's website. He presented different options that could be done. Bob stated Karen Winterholer maintains the town's site. Doug said when a superintendent is hired for the Goshen School District they will need to have a web site and will pass his information on.
- The Board discussed the doors to be replaced at the police department and town office. The Police door will have a window and buzzer to let the public access the room. The town office will have a new front door with a window. The old door will be installed on the front right of the building for an emergency exit. The cost of the project will be \$13,227.00. It will take 6 to 8 weeks for the doors to arrive after ordering. Bob made a motion to except the bid, Chip 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion.

The apron for the center road project will be done the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> week in September.

Doug stated the apron on the entrance to Province Road will not be done. The Paving Capital Reserve Fund wording state the monies can only be used for exciting paved roads.

The Board discussed replacing the 3 toilets in the town hall (police office, town office and town hall).

Bob stated the emergency management position is still vacant, one person has shown interest.

Bob stated the fire department, EMT's and police may want to receive training on using Narcan for drug overdose.
