Anderson and Davis Pit Annual Site Reviews
26 September 2015

Annual site visit/inspection of the Anderson and Davis pits called to order at 10am.

Item #1: Anderson Pit Review

Progress in the Anderson pit is ongoing with preparations for reseeded (areas that were damaged by heavy rain) are underway. Hydroseeding is planned to begin in October 2015. Loam for continued reclamation is also on site.

Mr. Carroll, Jr. estimates that approximately 90% of the reclamation will be completed by Spring 2016 but anticipates a need to file for a permit extension. The board briefly discussed with Mr. Carroll, Jr. whether a one-year permit versus a three-year permit would be ideal for the anticipated needs of the pit.

On a side note, there had been concerns about the noise from the back up beepers during pit operations. The Loader is radar equipped so that the back up beep does not emit a sound unless there is something within 25 feet of it; this is expected to reduce noise.

The Anderson pit is clear of trash and looks well maintained.

Item #2: Davis Pit Review

The Davis Pit continues to near lifetime completion with the exception of a small area of sand at the front of the pit. Reclamation is ongoing with Ernest Bridge/Unity lines nearly completely reclaimed.

Mrs. Bursey made a motion to accept the conditions of the Anderson and Davis Pits, Mr. Smith seconded, all were in favor, motion approved.

Mrs. Bursey made a motion to adjourn; Mr. Smith seconded the motion, all in favor. Meeting adjourned at 10:48am.
