The purpose of this hearing is for the continuation of an application for Newport Sand and Gravel for a special exception. This hearing is also to hear any public comments. Mr. Lawton state that there have been conversations between the Town council and the council for Mr. Carroll. Mr. Carroll would like to be heard before proceeding with the hearing.

Mr. Carroll state that the RSA states that there needs to be five people on the Zoning Board, and since there was a recent resignation of Hannah Lockwood, there are only presently four people on the Board. Mr. Carroll stated that due to this reason he would like to have a continuation of this hearing.

Mr. Lawton stated that he also talked to both of the councils and stated that it is in the best interest of the Town, and for the well being, that we accept the request for continuance. If any members of the public are not able to attend the continuance they should submit their comments in writing to the Zoning Board.

Attorney Waugh stated that it is unfortunate for the people that were going to give testimony tonight that Attorney Britain just brought up this issue this morning, and he was not able to contact all those involved. Attorney Waugh stated that he would honor the request to a continuance.

Mr. Lawton stated he would like to make a motion to continue the hearing until Tuesday July 21<sup>st</sup> at 7 p.m. All persons involved agreed that the date would be acceptable. All were in favor.

Mr. Lawton announced that there is an opening for the Zoning Board Secretary, and if anyone is interested in the position to see the Board of Selectman.

Mrs. Phillips made a motion to adjourn, Mr. Lawton seconded, and all were in favor to adjourn at approximately 7:10 p.m.
