Meeting called to order at 9:12 a.m.

Pit Inspection

Members of the Planning Board inspected both the Anderson and Davis Pits to fulfill the annual inspection requirement. The Anderson Pit has a new loader with a discretionary back up alarm which allows for a quieter work environment while still meeting MSHA standards.

Phase one of the Anderson Pit has been completed and the associated excavation permit will expire this month. Phase one will contain a working mound of loam to be used for reclamation throughout the remainder of the project, however no excavation will occur in the phase one area.

Mr. Carroll, Jr. advised that starting on Monday, October 22, 2018 trucks will be turning south out of the Anderson Pit and heading toward Unity on route 10. This flow of traffic will continue for approximately one month. South traveling traffic was applied for in all the applications including renewal for Anderson Pit and is allowed to occur.

Both pits were observed to be clean and in good order.

Fred Smith motioned to accept the annual inspection as complete without issue; Bruce Nadeau seconded the motion, all were in favor.

Bruce Nadeau motioned to adjourn the meeting; Fredric Smith seconded the motion, all were in favor.
