Planning Board
Minutes of March 21, 2019
FINAL**

Planning Board members present: Alicea Bursey (Chair), George Hebert (Vice-chair), and Stephen Bursey (3=quorum)

Meeting called to order at 7:10 p.m.

Town Election/Election of Officers

As the town vote to ratify election results has not occurred, the board will continue to operate as it was before the recent elections and wait for further instruction from the town.

Chair Bursey also mentioned to the board that unfortunately, due to a misunderstanding, previous warrant articles that had been presented to the public in November 2018 were not added to the town ballot for voting. Therefore, the proposed warrant articles will be presented again to the public in 2019 and then resubmitted for town vote in 2020.

Review of March 7, 2019 Meeting Minutes

Alicea Bursey motioned to accept the minutes from March 7, 2019. George Hebert seconded the motion. All were in favor, minutes approved 'as is'.

Truck Type Discussion

The board discussed load limits and truck types for hauling excavation materials over the Lear Hill bridge. The board believes that the only regulation that will need to be followed is the state regulation RSA 266 and any applicable local limit postings, or permits. Mr. Nadeau had informed Chair Bursey that he too had information from the state regarding loads and limits on the Lear Hill bridge. Until Mr. Nadeau has an opportunity to address the board with his information, no final discussion or vote will be made.

Member Discussion

The board discussed the current member situation; they agreed to continue the search for members and alternates. This will remain a standing item until filled.
