Minutes of Meeting
November 26, 2018

The meeting came to order at 6:05 p.m.

- Check reports were reviewed and signed.
- Jim Ricker from Wilcox & Barton was present to discuss the monitoring at the Transfer Station. Mr. Ricker stated he would give the selectmen a bid on the monitoring.
- Jerry Pritchett showed the Selectmen pictures of an abutting property to his. There is garbage and junk all over. A bank now owns the property and the Selectmen have reached out to the bank to clean the property up. The bank stated they would act on cleaning the property back in September, which did not happen. After several calls to the bank, they are not returning calls. The Selectmen are going to contact Town Council for advice.
- Alicia Bursey stated a resident asked why Kevin was driving Hersey Construction trucks. Kevin stated that having completed his full hours for Goshen, he was working on his own time for Hersey and not working for the Town.

Alicia stated a resident asked her why the minutes were not up to date on the web site. Cindy stated there had not been a selectmen meeting since October 22, and she does not post draft minutes on the web site. The draft minutes are posted at the post office and town office.

- Bob stated trees at the North cemetery had been cut without permission from the cemetery commission or Selectmen. Ronald Kempton, who is on the Cemetery Commission, asked Raymond Wentzell to cut the trees. Ronald paid Raymond for the job. The Selectmen will contact Legal Counsel regarding this matter.
