

***Town of Goshen
Board of Selectmen
Minutes of Meeting
May 5, 2015***

Present: Bob Bell, Edward Andersen, Sr., William “Chip” Ball, Peta Brennan, Bea Jillette, Jan Parmalee, John Hopkins and Cindy Rouillard

- The meeting came to order at 7:10 p.m.
- The check reports were reviewed and signed.
- The Board signed an Intent to Cut application.
- The Board signed a Letter to Heather Peckham, Treasurer to withdrawal \$20,000.00 from the transfer station account and deposit into the general fund that was voted on at town meeting
- Peta Brennan stated she had a list of topics to discuss:
 1. A lot of people’s phones do not work properly in Goshen. People have contacted Fairpoint with no answers. Peta stated it is time to take action on getting them repaired. She has contact the PUC and they say they are waiting for a part, etc. Jan stated that years ago her husband went around to the neighbors and had a petition signed. Peta said she wants to have a petition and put it in the town office for people to sign with their complaints. The Selectmen will follow thorough.
 2. There are trees on Center Road that are being cut which are not 50’ from the road which the RSA states is the length. Peta said she new Kevin had asked the land owner to cut them because they were affecting the ditches that were being dug and would need to be cut when the road is repaired. Peta said it appeared there were more than a few tress cut. Bob stated he would talk with Road Agent, Kevin the next day and find out why the other trees were cut.
 3. Peta stated there was logging going on at the end of Cross Road. It looked like it was being clear cut. She asked if the selectmen knew of any plans to do anything with the clearing. Cindy stated she spoke with the Forester when he filed the intent to cut and it was to manage the forest.
 4. Peta asked the Board if the health insurance would be going out to bid for next year. Bob stated the Board is planning on getting bids.
- John Hopkins asked about the report of cut for timber. Cindy explained the procedure to him.

John stated he was planning on reviewing some of the septic systems on Rand Pond to make sure everything is up to date.

John stated he left a voice mail to Chief Andersen regarding a house without indoor plumbing but Chief Andersen has not returned his call. The Board will following through and get back to him.
