Messer Road Boat Storage

The board reviewed the application that was presented by George Grant for a home-based commercial use business to be located on Messer Road. The application is to allow winter boat storage on the property. The board only voted on whether the application was complete.

Judy Dunn made a motion to accept the application as complete. Keith Hall seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Keith Hall made a motion to hold the public hearing for Mr. Grant's application during the next scheduled meeting. Judy Dunn seconded the motion. All were in favor, the public hearing will be held on November 14, 2018.
